Emotional Support Animal

In order to obtain a letter from a medical professional for an emotional support animal of any kind, your child must meet the following criteria:

1. A documented qualifying diagnosis. If you feel like your child has such a diagnosis please list:

2. Current therapy/counseling with a therapy plan that includes the emotional support pet (benefits, how is pet part of therapy etc). There must be communication from therapist on file with our office. Please document the name/agency of your child's counselor/therapist:

3. Documentation of symptoms that will be relieved or mitigated by the emotional support pet:

The medical professional will review the above information as well as the patient's record to determine eligibility.

Please recognize that a letter from a medical professional does not allow for pet to accompany patient onto aircraft or other public transportation. This letter also does not automatically exempt a renter from paying a required pet deposit. The medical professional does not assume any liability or risk posed by the emotional support pet.

There will be a fee assessed for completion of letter if above qualifications are met and letter is provided.
