*A tract of land located in the E/2 r-N-1 NE of Section 27, Township 16 North Range 25 East, I. B. & M, being more particularly described as follows:
Commencing at the NE corner of said Section 27; thence S01°48'51"E. along the East line thereof, 1321.75 feet to the SE corner of the NW NE, thence S88°07'03"W, along the South line thereof, 1322.9 feet to the SE corner of the E/2 NW NE, thence N01°51'25"W, along the East line thereof, 100.00 feet to the Point of Beginning, being a point where the North line of Highway 51 right of way intersects with the East line of the E/2 NW NE, thence N01°51'25"W, along the East line thereof, 295.00 feet thence S88°07'03"W. 295.00 feet: thence S01°51'25'E, 295.00 feet to the North right of way of Highway 51;*

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*thence N88°07'03"E, along said right of way, 295.00 feet to the Point of Beginning.
Containing 2.00 acres, more or less.*

*NOTE: The revised Property Description is the same property as described in original
deed filed In Book 197, Page 497. Description was revised to reflect survey performed.*

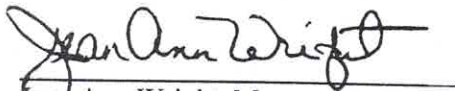
