



ORDINANCE 409-B

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 409 TO ESTABLISH GROUND SIGNAGE GUIDELINES IN AGREEMENT WITH THE CURRENT INTERNATIONAL BUILDING CODE AND RESERVING THE RIGHT TO GRANT VARIANCE BY THE COUNCIL AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Rules governing the erecting, placement, size, type, repair, maintenance and alteration of signs within the City of Stilwell are vital to the health and safety of the residents of the City of Stilwell, and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of this Council that adequate guidelines are essential for the placement, type, and size of signs within the City limits of Stilwell.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1

Ordinance 409 Section 6 – A – 2 – iii shall now read as follows:

Signs placed on separate poles or structures on the property may not exceed 35 feet in height for combustible signs and 100 feet for non-combustible signs and are limited to 60 square feet on either side of the sign.

SECTION 2

Ordinance 409 Section 6 – A – 2 – iv shall now read as follows:

Billboards within the City limits cannot be greater than 240 square feet on either side, may not exceed 35 feet in height for combustible signs and 100 feet for non-combustible signs, and placement will have to approved.

SECTION 3

Ordinance 409 Section 9 shall now include the following:


C. The City Council reserves the right to approve any variances it considers to be appropriate and in the best interest of the City.



Ordinance 409 Section 9 shall now include the following:

C. The City Council reserves the right to approve any variances it considers to be appropriate and in the best interest of the City.
