Why consider fertility preservation?

People choose to preserve their fertility for many reasons, including:

- **Age:** A person is born with all of the eggs they will ever have, and the quality and quantity of those eggs tend to decline with age. Sperm is produced throughout a person's life, but the health and vitality of sperm decrease as people get older. Fertility preservation at a younger age may increase the chances of a healthy pregnancy in the future.
- **Medical conditions:** Radiation, chemotherapy, hormone therapy, and some surgeries can have a negative impact on fertility. It's often possible to freeze eggs, sperm, reproductive tissue, or embryos before these treatments to protect a person's ability to have children.
- **Health conditions:** Conditions like sickle cell anemia, lupus, and rheumatoid arthritis can increase a person's risk of infertility, so fertility preservation may be recommended in some cases.
- **High-risk careers:** Exposure to radiation and toxic substances like pesticides, lead, metals, and petrochemicals may be harmful to fertility. It's also often recommended to freeze eggs, sperm, or embryos before starting a job with significant physical risks, like careers in the military and logging.
