

Ordinance No. 102

AN ORDINANCE TO LEVY A TAX ON THE PRIVILEGE OF ENGAGING IN ANY BUSINESS, TRADE, OCCUPATION, VOCATION, PROFESSION OR CALLING, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Town Council of the Incorporated town of Catter, Arkansas:

Section 1. The fees for licenses under this ordinance shall be as set opposite the business, trades, occupations, callings, and professions herein listed:
