

ORDINANCE 105

AN ORDINANCE GOVERNING THE CARE OF CEMETARY
LOTS IN COTTER CEMETARY

Be it ordained by the duly elected council of the
incorporated City of Cotter, Arkansas:

1. That it shall be unlawful for the owners, or persons
in whose charge any lots may be, to plant or otherwise
cause to grow any climbing vines or other plants that will
multiply in profusion over other lots.

2. That cemetery lots be sold to anyone for twenty
dollars. (\$20.00)

3. That it shall be unlawful for anyone to dump rocks,
or cut brush, or any other rubbish on vacant lots.

4. That anyone excavating or cleaning lots must haul
or carry from Cotter cemetery surplus dirt or rocks.

5. Any person violating any part of any section of this
ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon
conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum of not less
than five dollars (\$5.00) nor more than Ten dollars (\$10.00).

6. That this ordinance take effect and shall be in
force from and after passage and publication.
