

ORDINANCE 106

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING SANITATION AND THE
CARE OF ALLEYS IN THE INCORPORATED CITY OF
COTTER, ARKANSAS

Be it ordained by the duly elected council of the
Incorporated City of Cotter, Arkansas.

1. That it shall be unlawful for anyone to dump or
abandon in the alleys or gutters of the city of Cotter
rocks, brush, grass, weeds, bones, paper, boxes, cans,
ashes, wood or garbage.

2. That it shall be unlawful for anyone to allow waste
water from sinks, cesspools, laundries, outdoor toilets, or
water closets to drain into alleys or natural ditches so as
to cause obnoxious or offensive odors and a breeding place
for mosquitoes.

3. That outdoor toilets be constructed and maintained
over a pit at least 36 inches wide and four feet deep. That
such toilets be treated weekly with lime.

4. That all ordinances or resolutions or parts of
ordinances or parts of resolutions in conflict with this
ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

5. That any person violating any part of this ordinance
shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction
thereof shall be fined in any sum of not less than five
dollars (\$5.00) nor more than Ten dollars (\$10.00)

6. That this ordinance take effect and be in force
from and after passage and publication.
