

ORDINANCE NO. 117

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE TRAFFIC UPON THE STREETS OF COTTER, ARK.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE INCORPORATED TOWN OF COTTER, ARK.

All laws and parts of laws, rules and regulations of the State of Arkansas, regulating traffic upon the highways, state roads and public streets within the State of Arkansas, are by this ordinance adopted by the traffic laws, rules and regulations of the incorporated Town of Cotter Arkansas.

Section 2.

All penalties imposed by the State of Arkansas, for violations of such laws, rules and regulations above mentioned, are by this ordinance, adopted as the penalties for such violations within the incorporated Town of Cotter, Ark.

Section 3.

McClain Street between the West side of First St., and the East side of Second St., and Second Street between the South side of First St., and the North side of _____ street, are by this ordinance, designated as the "Business Section" of the town of Cotter.

Section 4.

No vehicle, of whatsoever kind, shall be parked within the town of Cotter within the "Business Section" except parallel to the curb and within the lines or marks designating the space and distance for such parking.

Section 5.

It shall be unlawful to disobey and marks, markers, signs or other insignia governing traffic or parking within the town of Cotter, Ark.

Section 6.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, are by this ordinance repealed.

Section 7. Should any part of the Ordinance be held invalid, by a court of competent jurisdiction it shall not effect the validity of the remaining parts of this Ordinance.

Section 7.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, signature of the Mayor, attestation of the Recorder and publication.
