EXCERPTS FROM MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE ARKANSAS HELD September 21, 1965 The <u>City</u> Council of the <u>City</u> of Cotter , Arkansas met in special session at its regular meeting place in ______ at _____ at ______ o'clock A.m. on the 21st day of September , 19 65. following were present: Mayor Frank G. Wallick; Recorder ; and Aldermen Brugan Dramill Q. W. Magness, Q. R. Wren E. L. Gillila. Absent: The Mayor announced that this was the time set for the public hearing to determine whether those signing the petition filed with the Recorder asking that the proposed natural gas distribution system and its related facilities to be constructed by the <u>City</u> of <u>Cotter</u>, Arkansas be leased to Arkansas Western Gas Company with an option to the lessee to purchase the leased property, constitute a majority in value of the owners of real property, within the <u>City</u> of <u>Cotter</u>, Arkansas. Mayor further stated that the notice of the public hearing had been duly published in a newspaper of general circulation in the __ctv_ of _____ cotter___ once a week for two consecutive weeks as required by law, as evidenced by proof of publication on file in the office of the Recorder. The Mayor then presented to the Council the certificate of the Recorder reciting that the assessed valuation of the real property within the ______ of _____ Cotter _____, Arkansas is \$248,684.00; that the persons signing said petition own property within the City of Cotter in the amount of \$ 145.670.00; and that the said petitioners,

therefore, are more than a majority in value of the owners of

real property within the <u>City</u> of <u>Cotter</u> , as
shown by the last county assessment. He directed that this
certificate be filed with the Recorder.
