

ORDINANCE NO. 2-1978

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE OF FIREWORKS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF COTTER, ARKANSAS, EXCEPT DURING THE PERIODS OF JUNE 20 THROUGH JULY 10 AND DECEMBER 10 THROUGH JANUARY 5 OF EACH YEAR, AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COTTER, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Except during the periods of June 20 through July 10 and December 10 through January 5, of each year, it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to shoot, explode, discharge, fire or set off any type of fireworks within the corporate limits of the City of Cotter, Arkansas, without first obtaining a written permit therefore from the City Council of said City.

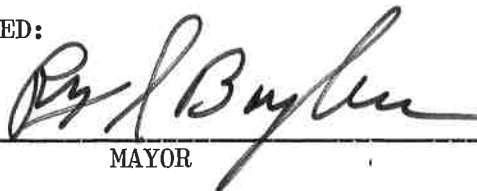
SECTION 2: Application for permit shall be made in writing to the City Council of the City of Cotter, Arkansas, setting forth the place, date, time and purpose for the shooting, exploding, discharging, firing or setting off of fireworks and, if same meets with approval of the City Council of said City, said Council shall direct the City Recorder to issue written permit therefore.

SECTION 3: Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined in a sum of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$100.00 for each and every violation.

SECTION 4: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
