AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL AND REVOKE ORDINANCE NO. 6-88 PASSED ON JUNE 2, 1988; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO EXIST; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on the 2nd day of June, 1988, the City Council passed and adopted Ordinance No. 6-88 entitled "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A FLOOD DAMAGE PREVENTION ORDINANCE PROGRAM FOR COTTER AND OTHER PURPOSES."; and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance No. 6-88 adopted by reference a Flood Damage Prevention Regulatory Code for Cotter, Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, since the passage of said Ordinance No. 6-88, certain rules, regulations, and determinations have been issued and made by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) regarding flood damage prevention, which are inconsistent with the current and projected planning by the City Council and other considerations pending now before the City Council; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council to discontinue the City's participation in a flood damage prevention program at the present time;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COTTER, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 6-88 of the City of Cotter, passed and adopted on the 2nd day of June, 1988, is hereby repealed and revoked in its entirety and hereafter shall have no effect or force of law whatever.

SECTION 2. The Flood Damage Prevention Regulatory Code for Cotter, Arkansas, adopted by reference in Ordinance No. 6-88, is hereby revoked in its entirety, and all the provisions thereof are hereby declared to be null and void.

SECTION 3. Any and all other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances found to be in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. The City Council has determined that the provisions of Ordinance No. 6-88 and the flood damage prevention code for Cotter, Arkansas adopted by reference, are no longer in the best interests of the citizens and residents of the City of Cotter and should be repealed, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance, being necessary for the protection and preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare shall take effect, and be in full force and effect, immediately upon its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
