

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE
#9-88----SECTION # 1:
"Establishing water rates to
be charged by the City of
Cotter, Arkansas, and other
matters pertaining, therefore;
and declaring an Emergency."

Whereas, the City of Cotter, Arkansas (the city)
owns and operates Water Facilities as on inter-
related Municipal undertaking (system).

Whereas, for purposes of identification the
facilities outside the City limits are referred
to as "District #2."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED
BY THE CITY OF COTTER, ARKANSAS:

(A) MONTHLY WATER RATES:

Section #1:

To Water Customers outside the City Limits (District #2) for
the first 2,000 gallons of water consumed, or any part there-
of, the sum of \$12.80, monthly charge; for the next additional
1,000 gallons, or any part thereof, \$3.50 per thousand. Over
3,000 gallons or any part thereof, the sum of \$2.80 per
1,000 gallons.

Section #11:

The provisions of the Ordinance are separable and if a sections,
phrase or provision shall be declared by a Court of competent
jurisdiction, such declaration shall not affect the validity
of the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section #111:

All water Ordinances, Resolutions and parts there-of in conflict
with the Water rates set forth herein are hereby cancelled,
annuled and forever held or nought, all such ordinances,
resolutions, and parts thereof which are not in conflict with
with the rates set forth herein are hereby reaffirmed and shall
continue in full force and effect.

Section 1V:

It is hereby ascertained that the revenue from the system does
not cover it expenses and obligations; that the additional
raise by Mountain Home Water System requires the City of Cotter
to raise its rates under such circumstances sufficiently to
discharge its expenses and obligations.

Section V:

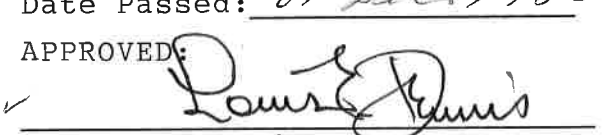
Therefore, this ordinance being necessary for the public peace,
