

ORDINANCE NO. 96-06

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DUMPING OF TRASH AND REFUSE WITHIN THE CITY OF COTTER, ARKANSAS; PROVIDING A PENALTY THEREFORE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COTTER, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. From and after the passage and approval of this ordinance it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to dump or throw any form of trash, refuse, cans, bottles, garbage, paper, rags, leaves, limbs, or any other kinds or form of trash or garbage upon the streets, alleys, ditchlines, in the park or upon any other property of or within the City of Cotter, Arkansas.

SECTION 2. PENALTY: Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00) nor more than TWO HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$250.00). And if such violation be continued, each days violation shall be a separate offense.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY: If any part of this ordinance shall be held void such part shall be deemed severable, an the invalidity thereof shall not affect the remaining parts of the ordinance.

SECTION 4. REPEAL: Ordinance number 141-A is hereby repealed. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

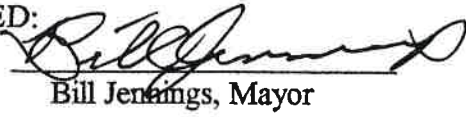

The city council of the City of Cotter, Arkansas has determined that the prohibiting of the dumping of trash and refuse on the public streets, alleys and ditchlines is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety. of the citizens. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall have full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
