ORDINANCE NO. 2001-11

ORDINANCE ABANDONING A PORTION OF PUBLIC ALLEY WITHIN THE CITY OF COTTER, ARKANSAS.

WHEREAS, a petition was duly filed with the City Council of the City of Cotter, Arkansas, asking for the City to vacate and abandon a portion of a public alley;

WHEREAS, after due notices as required by law, the Council has, at the time and place mentioned in the notice, heard all persons desiring to be heard on the question and ascertained that the alley described hereinafter has heretofore been dedicated to the public use as an alley but has not actually been used by the public generally for a period of at least five (5) years; that all the owners of the property abutting upon the portion of the alley to be vacated have given consent to the abandonment and that public interest and welfare will not be adversely affected by the abandonment of said alley.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Cotter, Arkansas:

- Sec. 1: The City of Cotter, Arkansas, releases, vacates and abandons all its rights, together with the rights of the public generally in and to the public alley designated as follows:
- That portion of a public alley which is west of 2nd Street and runs east and west between Lots A and Lots 241, 242, 243, 244, 245, 246 and 247 within the City of Cotter, Arkansas.
- Sec. 2: A copy of the ordinance duly certified by the City Recorder shall be filed in the office of the recorder of the county and recorded in the deed records of the county.

Sec. 3: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
