## Ordinance #2018-02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE POLICY AND PROCEDURES MANUAL OF THE COTTER POLICE DEPARTMENT RELATING TO THE LAW ENFORCEMENT EXPERIENCE REQUIRED FOR A K-9 OFFICER OF THE CITY OF COTTER, ARKANSAS

WHEREAS, the manual mandated that a K-9 officer of the City of Cotter have a minimum of two years law enforcement experience; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interest of the City of Cotter and its citizens to modify the experience requirement as it relates to K-9 officers of the City of Cotter.

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDANIED BY THE CITY OF COTTER, ARKANSAS:

- 1. That Ordinance No 2016-03 of the City of Cotter, Arkansas, adopted the Policy and Procedures Manual of the Cotter Police Department. The Policy and Procedures Manual provides, in part, as follows; "Requirements for a Department K-9 Officer:
  - a) Have a minimum of two years full time law enforcement experience."
- 2. That said portion of the Policy and Procedures Manual shall be modified to read as follows: "Requirements for a Department K-9 Officer:
  - a) Shall be a fully certified police officer under the laws of the State of Arkansas and shall have completed all required training in K-9 handling. The individual serving in the capacity of K-9 officer shall be hired only with the approval of the Chief of Police and the Mayor of the City of Cotter."
- 3. All other provisions of the Policy and Procedures Manual of the Cotter Police Department, including, but not limited to, all provisions regarding a Department K-9 Officer, shall remain in full force and effect unless specifically changed by the terms of the Ordinance.
