

ORDINANCE NO. 97

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A LICENSE UPON TAXICABS

Be it ordained by the town council of the Incorporated Town of Cotter, Arkansas:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation in the Incorporated Town of Cotter, Arkansas to operate a taxicab or to be interested in the operation of a taxicab within the incorporated limits of the Town, without first having obtained and paid an annual license therefor. The license fee for each taxicab shall be \$10.00 per annum and shall be payable to the town recorder. The license shall contain the name of the person to whom issued; and the motor number, make and model of car, and the Arkansas license number of the vehicle for which the license is issued. The license may be transferred to a different person or a different vehicle by surrendering same to the recorder and paying a transfer fee of \$1.00.

Section 2. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined in any sum not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$100.00.
