

RESOLUTION NO. 7-77

A RESOLUTION FOR BOARDING DOGS AT PET HAVEN AND TO
MAKE PAYMENT THEREFOR

WHEREAS, on February 16, 1977, the City Council of Cotter, Arkansas, enacted Ordinance No. 1-77 entitled "An ordinance prohibiting dogs from running at large and providing the licensing of dogs within the City of Cotter, Arkansas, and providing penalties for non-compliance with ordinance"; and

WHEREAS, provision must be made for the disposition of non-licensed dogs and/or dogs running at large within said City of Cotter, Arkansas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COTTER, ARKANSAS:

SECTION I: That dogs picked up because of violation of the aforesaid ordinance shall be delivered to Pet Haven which has agreed to keep each dog delivered for three (3) days at a charge of \$5.00 to the City, *Pet Haven to dispose of the dog after said 3-day period.*

SECTION II: The owner of any such dog may redeem said dog from Pet Haven by first obtaining from the Mayor or Recorder/Treasurer of the City the right to do so and such owner shall pay to Pet Haven the usual per day charge of Pet Haven for keeping dogs.

SECTION III: The Mayor and Recorder/Treasurer be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to pay to Pet Haven the sum of \$5.00 for each dog delivered by the City of Cotter to Pet Haven, not claimed by its owner, for the keeping of said dog for the aforesaid three (3) day period.
