

RESOLUTION NO. 9-78

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING COMPENSATION TO GAS INSPECTOR

WHEREAS, the City of Cotter, Arkansas, hereinafter referred to as "City", has heretofore passed an Ordinance No. 133 entitled "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE INSTALLATION, ALTERATION, AND MAINTENANCE OF ALL PIPING EXTENDING FROM THE POINT OF DELIVERY OF GAS FOR USE AS A FUEL AND DESIGNED TO CONVEY OR CARRY THE SAME TO GAS APPLIANCES, AND REGULATING THE INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF APPLIANCES DESIGNED TO UTILIZE SUCH GAS AS A FUEL, WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF COTTER ARKANSAS; PROVIDING FOR THE INSPECTION OF SAID PIPING AND INSTALLATION OF SAID PIPING AND CERTAIN APPLIANCES AND THE COLLECTION OF INSPECTION FEES THEREFOR; PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING OF PERSONS ENGAGING IN THE BUSINESS OF INSTALLING, REPAIRING, OR MAINTAINING SAID PIPING OR CERTAIN APPLIANCES; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE, AND REPEALING ALL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES.

WHEREAS, it is necessary that provision be made for payment to the Gas Inspector under said ordinance for his duties as set forth in said ordinance;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COTTER, ARKANSAS:

That the sum of \$5.00 be charged for each gas inspection, the Gas Inspector to receive therefrom the sum of \$3.00 and the City of Cotter to receive therefrom the sum of \$2.00, payment of said \$5.00 to be made either to the Gas Inspector or at the Cotter City Hall as may be decided upon between the Gas Inspector and the City Recorder, and further, that not less than 24 hours prior notice of each required gas inspection must be given to the Gas Inspector by the person requiring such inspection.
