

RESOLUTION NO. 6-80

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE WILLINGNESS
OF THE CITY OF COTTER TO MATCH
STATE-AID CITY STREET FUNDS FOR THE
IMPROVEMENT OF CERTAIN STREETS
IN COTTER, ARKANSAS, MORE PARTICULARLY
HEREINAFTER SET FORTH

WHEREAS, The City of Cotter understands State Aid City Street Funds are available for improvements to the city streets; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that the top priority project is Capitol Street, between Highway 62 and Melba Avenue, and McClean Street, between Fifth Street and Boyd Hill.

WHEREAS, the City will be responsible for all costs above the amount in the State Aid Street Fund (a minimum 30% City Funds);

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COTTER, ARKANSAS, THAT:

Section I: The City of Cotter will participate in accordance with its designated responsibility in this project.

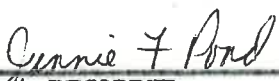
Section II: The City of Cotter pledges its full support and hereby authorized and requests the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department to initiate action to construct this project.
