RESOLUTION NO. 10-1981

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PURCHASE OF POLICE CAR

WHEREAS, the police car owned by the City of Cotter, Arkansas, (City), is not adequate for the use to which it is put, it having been driven over 150,000 miles and the engine having broken down recently and replaced by a second-hand engine, the only engine available on short notice, and it is now not adequate for the necessary speed for a police car and is very likely to break down at anytime;

WHEREAS, the police car used by George Mann, Marshal of the City of Flippin, Arkansas, is available for purchase for the sum of \$2,500.00 with no modification needed for the installation of equipment, such places being already provided, said car having been driven approximately 34,000 miles and being a 1976 4-door Dodge Sedan; and

WHEREAS, an emergency exists in that it is believed that the present police car will not last much longer for use as a police car;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Cotter, Arkansas, that the City purchase the aforesaid 1976 Dodge 4-door Sedan heretofore used as a police car by George Mann, Marshal of the City of Flippin, Arkansas, for the sum of \$2,500.00 and the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Cotter, Arkansas, are hereby authorized and directed to make such purchase and sign such papers as may be necessary in connection therewith; and be it further resolved that the funds in the Special Account for the replacement of police car be used for this purpose, any additional funds which may be needed to be paid from the City General Fund, It is hereby declared that an emergency exists and that this purchase should be made forthwith.
