

RESOLUTION NO. 4-1984

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE FORMATION OF A BAXTER-MARION
COUNTY REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION

WHEREAS, in recognition of the common interests of Marion County, Arkansas and Baxter County, Arkansas, and the beneficial economic impact to both Counties of the development and location of new industry and promotion of increased tourism in the area;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COTTER located in Baxter County, Arkansas:

1. BE IT RESOLVED that said City in co-operation with its Mayor and with the majority support of the City Council does hereby urge, endorse, and encourage the formation of a Baxter-Marion Regional Development Commission, and;
2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Cotter, Arkansas, seeks to unite with the county governments, municipal governments and chamber of commerce and other agencies and organizations within the Bi-County region to aid in the industrial and tourism promotion of this area, and;
3. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the formation of this commission be composed of representatives of the governments and organizations listed above in order to promote the financial well being and direct the course of the commission for the mutual benefit of the area, its business community and its citizens, and;
4. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the proposed commission concern itself with the immediate goal of increasing tourism visitation, tourism related businesses, industrial relocations, as well as the acknowledgement and establishment of closer working relationships with existing area industry, and;
5. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the function of this commission be broadened to aid in the development of a long term area master plan along with cooperative efforts to solve area problems in transportation, solid waste disposal, waste water treatment, state or federal legislation and other areas within the scope of the commission according to its by-laws.

THIS RESOLUTION shall be in full force and effect on and after its passage and approval.
