

RESOLUTION NO. 8-1984

WHEREAS, in order to have funds for the expenses to be incurred by the City of Cotter, Arkansas, during the year 1985, it is necessary that the taxes for 1984, to be collected in the year 1985, be fixed on property within the City of Cotter, Arkansas, and the request for such purpose be presented to the Quorum Court of Baxter County, Arkansas, as it can consider, fix and assess said taxes at its meeting on November 6, 1984;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COTTER, ARKANSAS,

That the following taxes be, and they hereby are, set and fixed on property within the City of Cotter, Arkansas, for the year 1984:

1. a 5 mill tax for general operation of said City;
2. a 5 mill voluntary tax for the useage of the Fire Department of said City;
3. a 3 mill voluntary tax for the use of the Police Department of said City.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and the Recorder of said City be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to inform the Honorable Arnold R. Knight, County Clerk of Baxter County, Arkansas, and the Honorable Joe Dillard, County Judge of Baxter County, Arkansas, of the setting of taxes as aforesaid and to formally request that levy of said taxes be made for the year 1984 on the property within the City of Cotter, Arkansas.
