

RESOLUTION NO: 4-1985

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF NATIONAL FLAG DAY, JUNE 14, 1985

WHEREAS, the Continental Congress of the United States adopted a National Flag on June 14, 1777; and

WHEREAS, the United States Congress officially designated June 14 at National Flag Day in 1949; and

WHEREAS, the Star-Spangled Banner Flag House has officially sponsored Flag Week since 1952; and

WHEREAS, the National Flag Day Foundation, Inc. in Baltimore, Maryland was created in 1982 to plan National Flag Day ceremonies and to encourage patriotism by promoting the Pledge of Allegiance; and

WHEREAS, this year on June 14, 1985 at 7:00 p.m. EDT, Americans everywhere in the nation - lead by President Reagan and Governors of the 50 states - are asked to pause to say the "Pledge of Allegiance" to the Flag of the United State of America:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Cotter, Arkansas, urges its members, their families and their friends to join in this effort.
