

Resolution No. 7-86

A RESOLUTION ALLOWING PERSONS WITH LOW INCOME TO
CONNECT TO WATER LINE IN PART OF COTTER WATER DIST.
NO. 2 DURING A LIMITED TIME.

WHEREAS, the City of Cotter, Arkansas (City) has received a grant from Arkansas Industrial Development Commission, part of said grant to be used to allow persons with low income to connect to water line in that part of the City's Water District No. 2, beginning North of the Hopewell Baptist Church, running thence in a Westerly direction along U.S. Highway no. 62 to the Easterly boundary line of Gassville, Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, the term "gross income" means the total of all income, whether it be interest, dividends, pensions, social security of wages or any other income of whatsoever kind or nature, of persons occupying each household as follows:

No. of Persons in Household	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT:

RESOLVED that persons, whose annual gross income is that or lower than set forth above, may connect to water in Cotter Water District No. 2 as limited above, free of all charges except \$20.00 for meter deposit; and be it further, RESOLVED that applications for such water connections in said District shall be taken for a limited time only, that is, during the construction period; thereafter no applications will be taken.
