

RESOLUTION NO. 806

WHEREAS, the voters of Arkansas, including many municipal officials and municipal employees, have circulated petitions to place the Tax Reform Amendment on the November 8, 1988 General Election Ballot and;

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State has certified that these petitions are sufficient and the Arkansas Supreme Court has approved the ballot title and popular name of the Tax Reform Amendment, and;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Officials of Arkansas meeting at the 54th ANNUAL CONVENTION OF THE ARKANSAS MUNICIPAL LEAGUE on June 14, 1988, unanimously adopted a resolution urging all municipal officials to actively support the Tax Reform Amendment at the General Election on November 8, 1988.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY (OR TOWN) COUNCIL OF THE CITY (OR TOWN) OF Dooter, ARKANSAS.

Section 1. That the City (or town) Council of Dooter, Arkansas does support and urges all the citizens of Arkansas to support and vote FOR proposed Constitutional Amendment No 4 of 1988.

"AN AMENDMENT TO REPEAL THE PERSONAL PROPERTY TAX ON HOUSEHOLD GOODS; TO REQUIRE A VOTE OF SIXTY PERCENT OF THE LEGISLATURE OR APPROVAL BY POPULAR REFERENDUM TO LEVY OR AMEND ANY TAX; AND TO AUTHORIZE A CONSOLIDATION OF PROCEDURES FOR MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION".

Section 2. This resolution shall be published in the local newspaper and the clerk (or Recorder) shall mail copies of this resolution to all newspapers, T.V. Stations and radio stations in our area.
