

A RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO AND CONCERNING THE PROPOSAL FOR A COUNTY-WIDE ONE CENT SALES TAX FOR THE COUNTY OF BAXTER, ARKANSAS.

WHEREAS, the County Judge and the Quorum Court of Baxter County, Arkansas have announced their intention to call a Special Election to allow the qualified voters of the County to decide for or against a one cent county sales tax for the County of Baxter; and

WHEREAS, the voters of the City of Cotter at the election held on October 19, 19 82 adopted a one cent city sales tax for the City of Cotter and such tax continues to remain in effect in the City; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Cotter, Arkansas desire to register their official support of the proposal for said county tax, as a replacement for the existing one cent city sales tax; and

WHEREAS, if the proposed one cent county sales tax should be adopted by the voters, it is the desire of the Mayor and City Council to give the voters of the City of Cotter the opportunity to abolish the one cent city sales tax currently in effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COTTER, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. It is the collective and uniform desire and official position of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Cotter that a one cent county sales tax be adopted; and that it replace the existing one cent city sales tax.

Section 2. In the event that a one cent county sales tax is adopted at the special election to be held for that purpose, then it is the desire and intention of the Mayor and City Council to immediately present and adopt an Ordinance calling for a special election in the City of Cotter, to allow the voters of the City an opportunity to abolish and repeal the existing one cent city sales tax.

Section 3. The Recorder-Treasurer is hereby directed to deliver a certified copy of this Resolution to the County Judge and Quorum Court of Baxter County, Arkansas, conveying the support of the Mayor and City Council for the proposed one cent county sales tax.
