

RESOLUTION NUMBER 96-03

RESOLUTION REGARDING CHANGES IN CERTAIN STREET NAMES AS REQUIRED FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE ENHANCED 911 EMERGENCY RESPONSE SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, The City of Cotter, Arkansas desires to become a part of the Baxter County E-911 Emergency Response System, and

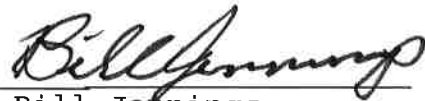
WHEREAS, Certain specified streets will be renamed to offer the least confusion to an Emergency Driver answering a call for help by a resident of Cotter.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of Cotter, Arkansas that the following changes shall go into effect upon the installation of correct street name signs:

1. Highway 62B from Combs Street to junction of Highway 62/412 will be known as Harding Boulevard.
2. Street from First Street to R.M. Ruthvan Bridge shall be known as: Ruthvan Street.
3. State Highway 345 From Junction of First and Combs to Junction of Highway 62/412 in Gassville shall be known as: Cotter Road.
4. Walnut Hill Lane shall be so named for the entire length.
5. Hargis Avenue shall be known as Hargis Place.
6. First Street between Highway 345 and White River shall be known as: Trout Dock Trail.
7. Wallick Road from Denton Ferry Road to Virginia Lee shall be known as: Rainbow Heights Drive.
8. Wallick Road shall be known as: Wallick Drive.
9. Rainbow Crossing Subdivision shall be numbered using the 5.28 addressing scheme starting at the entrance off Highway 62/412.
10. Highway 62/412 from Gassville City Limits to Bobby Hopper Bridge shall be known as: West Main, with numbering to continue at 5.28 intervals from said city limits.
