RESOLUTION NO. 99-01

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A POLICY ON LAW ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY OUTSIDE OF JURISDICTION IN ACCORDANCE TO ACT 846.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COTTER, ARKANSAS THAT:

SECTION 1: A police officer of the City of Cotter, Arkansas, is hereby granted arrest authority in the State of Arkansas when he/she is working at the request of or with permission of the municipal, city or county law enforcement agency having jurisdiction in that local area.

SECTION 2: Police officers of this City shall obtain permission from the Chief of Police or his/her designate prior to assisting another law enforcement agency. In the event of an emergency call for assistance from another law enforcement agency, the Chief of Police or his/her designate may grant permission to officers to respond to the call for assistance.

SECTION 3: Police officers are discouraged from making arrests in another jurisdiction unless accompanied by an officer from the agency having jurisdiction or permission from the agency having jurisdiction. In the event of a serious crime, officers who have received permission from the agency having jurisdiction may take the necessary law enforcement action, if it can be done safely.

<u>SECTION 4</u>: When working with another law enforcement agency, police officers of this City will continue to be governed by the rules, regulations, policies and procedures of the City of Cotter Police Department.
