A FAIR HOUSING RESOLUTION

WHEREAS: The Congress of the United States of America has declared that all citizens of the United States have the same right to inherit, purchase, lease, sell, hold, and convey real property and the said Congress of the United States of America has, hereby, declared that open housing is to be the law of the land;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COTTER, ARKANSAS, THAT:

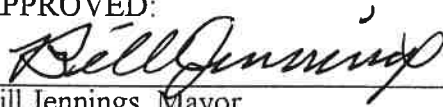
Section 1: It is hereby declared that the policy of the City of Cotter is to adhere to and comply with all laws prohibiting discriminatory policies and practices based on color, race, creed, disability, gender or national origin in relation to both the private and public use of housing and property ownership. It is hereby declared to be the policy of the City of Cotter to comply with all provisions of the law dealing with open housing and discrimination in any manner relating thereto.

Section 2: It is further herewith resolved that the City of Cotter will utilize its efforts and energies to end any discrimination within the City of Cotter.

This Resolution is to be in full force and in effect from the date of its passage.
