WHEREAS, the Baxter County Public Library Foundation, Inc., the supporting organization for the Baxter County Library, has conducted a needs assessment, completed and updated a strategic plan, conducted a feasibility study and a sustainability study and has begun work on a building design for a new library building; and

WHEREAS, the Foundation is planning to apply for a Donald W. Reynolds building grant to build a library on the 6.5 acre site, and is conducting a capital campaign to raise the 20% community match required by the Reynolds Foundation;

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it resolved that the Cotter City Council appreciates and supports the Baxter County Library Foundation's plan to apply for the Donald W. Reynolds building grant and supports the Investing in Your Place to Grow capital campaign.
