**A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE WILLINGNESS OF
THE CITY OF COTTER TO UTILIZE FEDERAL-AID MONEYS**

WHEREAS, the City of Cotter applied for funding through the Arkansas Safe Routes to School Program to develop or improve Cotter Public School zones with the use of beacon lighting, and

WHEREAS, the City of Cotter understands that Federal-Aid Funds are available for this project on a reimbursable basis, requiring work to be accomplished and proof of payment prior to actual monetary reimbursement, and

WHEREAS, this project, using federal funding, will be open and available for use by the general public and maintained by the City of Cotter.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COTTER CITY COUNCIL THAT:

SECTION I. The City of Cotter will participate in accordance with its designated responsibility, including maintenance of this project.

SECTION II. The City of Cotter Mayor, Peggy Hammack, and/or Recorder/Treasurer, Sharon Sugg, are hereby authorized and directed to execute all appropriate agreements and contracts necessary to expedite the construction of the above stated project.

SECTION III. The Cotter City Council pledges its full support and hereby authorizes the City of Cotter to cooperate with the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department to initiate action to implement this project.
