## A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE DESTRUCTION OF CERTAIN OUTDATED DOCUMENTS OF THE COTTER ACCOUNTING OFFICE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

**WHEREAS**, the City of Cotter, Accounting Office and Water Clerk office has accumulated a large number of outdated records and materials; and

WHEREAS, due to the lack of storage space, it has become necessary to destroy (recycle via compactor) these documents to allow current data adequate space to be stored; and

WHEREAS, Arkansas Code Annotated §14-59-114 allows for the destruction of said records if supported by an affidavit signed by the municipal employees overseeing the destruction of city records.

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF COTTER, ARKANSAS, THAT:

SECTION 1: Pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated §14-59-114, the supporting affidavit signed by Cotter Bookkeeper and Water Clerk, the City Council does hereby authorize the destruction of various documents as set forth in the affidavit attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by this reference.

SECTION 2: This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.
