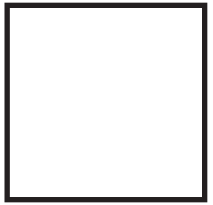

Adopt-A-Bin: A Simple Way to Support Warrick County CASA Kids

Warrick County CASA is dedicated to advocating for children involved in the child welfare system. Part of that mission includes making sure children, parents, and placements have access to everyday essentials — items that make a real difference in their comfort and stability.

Our *Adopt-A-Bin* program gives individuals, families, and community groups an easy, hands-on way to help. Each bin focuses on a particular category, such as toys, household and baby essentials, clothing, hygiene items, or adult care supplies. When you or your group “adopts” a bin, you’ll be notified whenever supplies are

running low. Donated items must be new and can be purchased through our Amazon Wish List, shipped directly to our office from any retailer, or dropped off in person. Because the needs of the children we serve change frequently, refill requests may occur at different times depending on ages, sizes, and case volumes. For our high-demand “big ticket” items like diapers and wipes, we aim to have two or more adopters per bin to help sustain supply levels year-round.

Once you sign up, you’ll receive an email with current bin details and any additional information you need to get started.
