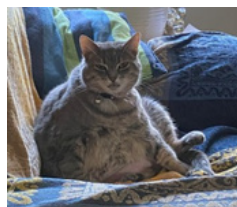
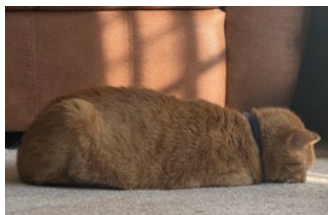
### HOBBIES

### Why I became CASA?

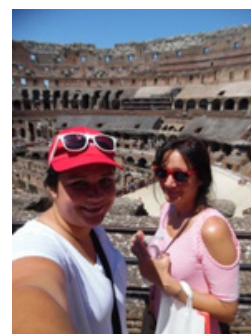
Well, there are any number of reasons why I joined CASA. The most important is that I like to support and help young people.

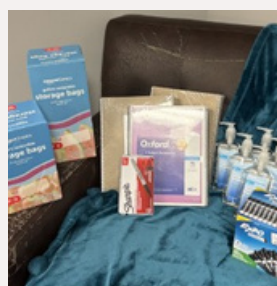

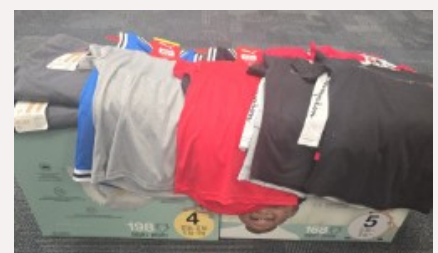
