

This afternoon, I send word that our brother priest and friend, Reverend Mario P. Farana died today at Saint Paul Parish in San Francisco at the age of 80 years.

Fr. Farana was ordained to the priesthood by Archbishop Joseph T. McGucken at the Cathedral of Saint Mary of the Assumption in San Francisco 54 years ago on May 29, 1971. Fr. Farana served in the Archdiocese from June 1, 1971, until August 4, 2025. He served in the following parishes: Saint John the Evangelist Parish, San Francisco, Saint Catherine of Siena Parish, Burlingame, Saint Paul Parish, San Francisco, Saint Michael Korean Parish, San Francisco, Saint Stephen Parish, San Francisco, and back to St. Paul's. In 2020 he accepted the position as pastor of the Noe Valley Cluster (Saint Philip the Apostle, Saint James, and Saint Paul) in San Francisco. Fr. Farana also served in the Vocations Office at the Chancery, as a faculty member at Marin Catholic High School, Kentfield and as the Chaplain for Sacred Heart High School, San Francisco.
