Dear Parents,

Jesus said, "Let the children come to me." (Matthew 19:1)

In response to Jesus' words, we **welcome** all children in the Noe Valley Cluster of Catholic Parishes and Schools (St. Paul, St. Philip, St. James) to our Faith Formation Programs — (Kindergarten through Grade 8) and Confirmation!

We recognize the importance of Catholic faith, morals, and virtues in the lives of children, and we are committed to passing on the teachings of Jesus and the Catholic Church to help them incorporate these values into their daily lives. Our mission is to accompany your child and your family on your faith journey through participation in Faith Formation classes and weekly Eucharistic Liturgy.

Faith Formation Programs:

- Parish Faith Formation (Kindergarten Grade 8/Confirmation I)
 Students—whether they attend public, private, or charter schools—who wish to learn more about the Catholic faith, grow in their relationship with God, and receive the Sacraments of Baptism, First Reconciliation, and Eucharist are invited to register for the Parish Faith Formation Program. The program offers weekly Faith Formation classes on Saturdays from 9:30 AM to 11:00 AM at St. Paul's school building
- Noe Valley Catholic Churches Confirmation II
 Students who have completed 8th grade at St. Paul's, or are currently in 8th grade at St. Philip's School or St. James School, are invited to register for Confirmation Year II.
 The sessions meet twice a month on Mondays from 6:30 PM to 8:00 PM at St. Paul's Church.
- Sacramental Preparation Class (Kindergarten Grade 8/Confirmation I)

 If your child, aged 7 or older, is registered in the Parish Faith Formation or enrolled in a Catholic school and would like to receive the Sacrament of Baptism, or if your child is in Grade 3 or above and would like to receive First Reconciliation and First Eucharist, he or she must attend the Sacramental Preparation Class once a month before receiving the Sacrament(s). These classes take place during the regular Faith Formation sessions on Saturdays from 9:30 AM to 11:00 AM at St. Paul's school building.

Reception of each Sacrament — Baptism, Reconciliation, Eucharist, and Confirmation — requires **two years of formation**:

- Grade 2: Reception of the Sacrament of Reconciliation
- Grade 3: Reception of the Sacrament of Eucharist
- **Grade 8/High School**: Confirmation Year I Preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation
- **Grade 8/High School**: Confirmation Year II Reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation

Open Registration:

To register your child(ren) in the Parish Faith Formation Programs (Kindergarten-Grade 8 / Confirmation I) or Confirmation II, please submit the registration forms to St. Paul's Parish Office (221 Valley Street, SF), Monday-Friday, from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM, or on one of the following weekends:

- August 16, 2025: 3:00–4:30 PM and 5:30–6:00 PM, St. Paul's Parish Center
- August 17, 2025: 9:00–11:30 AM, St. Paul's Parish Center
- August 23, 2025: 3:00–4:30 PM and 5:30–6:00 PM, St. Paul's Parish Center
- August 24, 2025: 9:00–11:30 AM, St. Paul's Parish Center

The deadline to submit registration forms is August 29, 2025.

Registration Fees:

- **Kindergarten through Grade 8/Confirmation I**: \$60.00 per child includes textbooks, supplies, and social events
- First Eucharist: Additional \$60.00 covers retreat, gifts, and 1st Eucharist photos
- Confirmation II: \$130.00 per child includes textbooks, supplies, retreat, and gifts

The Church reminds us that "parents have the first responsibility for the education of their children" (Catechism of the Catholic Church #2223). We encourage you to enroll your child(ren) in the Faith Formation Program, where they can grow in the virtues of faith, hope, and love. We also strongly encourage your family to participate in the weekly Eucharistic Liturgy, so that you and your child(ren) may be nourished by God's love and united with Him — in this life and in the life to come. As Blessed Carlo Acutis said, "The Eucharist is the highway to heaven."

CONFIRMATION II PROGRAM

Students who have completed 8th grade at St. Paul's, or are currently in 8th grade at St. Philip's School or St. James School are invited to register for Confirmation II Program.

Sacrament of Confirmation

Confirmation is a sacramental outpouring of the Holy Spirit that leaves a permanent imprint on the soul, completes Christian initiation, and empowers us to be witnesses to Christ. (*Catechism of the Catholic Church* #1285.)

Role of the Confirmation Candidate

The candidate is to discern whether he or she wishes to be confirmed in the Catholic faith. The candidate is expected to bring a positive attitude and an active and critical mind to the process. He or she is encouraged to ask questions, discuss faith with their sponsor, and prayerfully consider whether they are called to discipleship.

Expectations of the Candidate:

- 1. Attend all sessions and complete all entries in the candidate's book.
- 2. Attend weekly Mass.
- 3. Commit to consistent personal prayer throughout the journey.
- 4. Engage in parish/community service.
- 5. Participate in the Confirmation retreat.

Role of the Family

The role of the family is to support the Confirmation process by sharing faith with the candidate, assisting in finding and completing Acts of Justice (service projects), and supporting the candidate's discernment.

Expectations of the parent:

- 1. Models the commitment to personal prayer, community worship, and ministry expected of a mature Christian.
- 2. Assumes responsibility for assisting the candidate in meeting attendance and service requirements.
- 3. Agrees to help the candidate understand the experience of the journey—entering into dialogue, praying for and with the candidate, and sharing their personal faith story.

Role of the Confirmation Sponsor

A sponsor journeys with the candidate, offers a guidance, support, prayer, listening, and affirmation throughout the journey of the candidate. The sponsor should also commit to maintaining a relationship with the candidate **after** the sacrament, helping them live out their mission as a fully initiated Catholic. **The Sponsor's role includes:**

- Attending required sessions as part of the Confirmation program
- Maintaining ongoing contact and building a relationship with the candidate
- Attending the Rite of Confirmation

The sponsor should be:

- A baptized Catholic in good standing
- Fully initiated (has received Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist)
- At least 16 years of age
- Either male or female
- Sufficiently mature to fulfill their responsibilities
- A person who witnesses to the Catholic faith through their discipleship in word and action
- Willing to journey with the candidate throughout the Confirmation process

Meetings and Expectations for Parents, Sponsors, and Candidates

- Candidate attends all Confirmation sessions
- Candidate attends weekly Mass
- Parent and candidate attend the Orientation on September 22, 2025, from 6:30-7:30 PM at St. Paul's Church
- Sponsor and candidate attend Mass and Meeting on February 1, 2026: 9:15 AM Mass followed by the meeting at St. Paul's Church
- Candidate attends the mandatory retreat on February 21, 2026, from 9:00 AM-6:00 PM at St. Paul's Church
- Candidate receives the **Sacrament of Reconciliation** during the retreat
- Candidate completes 10 hours of service (community or parish related)
- Candidate chooses a Confirmation Saint Name

SACRAMENTS:

If your child(ren) is 7 years or older and has not been baptized, or if they are in grade 3 or above and have not received the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and Eucharist, please inform the teacher, catechist, or Sr. Mary Margaret so they can begin Sacramental preparation.
