    - Lilacs, forsythia, mums, peonies, any flower that endures after cutting.
    - Spruce, fir, holly, cedar, pine boughs for Christmas decorating
    - Pumpkins, gourds, wheat, vines for fall decorating
    - Curly willow, Corylus Avellana, and other unique branches
