Mission

The role of a Funeral Coordinator is to support the Priest and St Joe's Staff Members when funeral masses are planned. Funeral Coordinators serve the function by welcoming parishioners and visitors to the funeral.

You are a minister of hospitality, and part of your ministry is to make people feel welcome. You will minister in conjunction with the St. Joe's Staff, who will be present to support the families and guests in attendance at the funeral. Your job as a Coordinator is to greet them and get the church set up for mass.

What Does Your Committee Provide

Greet people as they come into the church
Set Up the Church (Funeral & Communion)
Distribute Communion if needed
Clean up after the funeral mass
-About a 2-hour commitment
