What Does Your Committee Provide

We provide a weekly Sunday Night experience during the school year for high school teens (9th through 12th) to gather in a comfortable environment. We provide the teens with opportunities to encounter God in food and fellowship, energy and excitement, moving talks and testimonies, and conversations with each other in small groups. All of this is surrounded in prayer by the Core Team. We also carve out 30 minutes of silent adoration for each of the teens at the end of the night.

Who Is Your Target Audience For Participants

Our target audience is high school teens in grades 9-12. Religious denomination does not matter, the School in which the teens attend. In March, we welcome 8th Graders to join!

Who Is Your Target Audience For Volunteers

Our target volunteer support is those who are 1 year fully removed from high school, living out an active Catholic faith, and willing to spend 2 hours a week with high school teens. We have many college-aged and young adult volunteers, but we have also had parents and coaches of the kids in our ministry be involved.

We also have parents who make sacrifices to provide us with food for the night, which helps our ministry so much.

What Are The Ministry's Greatest Needs

Food Team Volunteers: We could use Food Team Volunteers who are able to provide food once a month in support of our ministry such as 24 cans of soda, or 4 dozen cookies, or something similar. Once a semester, each food team makes the meal as well for the teens.

6 pm Mass Ushers: 6:00 p.m. Mass is a great beginning to our Sunday night. We could always use more people willing to usher at the 6:00 pm Mass. Disclaimer: The duties are simpler than any of the other masses the parish offers.
