Our current Under One Roof Food Pantry had its start as an outreach project of the Women of St. Paul's organization over twenty years ago. Funded by the proceeds of the annual Christmas Auction, it was little more than a collection of canned goods housed in a basement closet in the church.

Today, the Under One Roof Food Pantry and Emergency Fund is a collaborative effort involving six Maumee area churches, community agencies, local merchants, schools, organizations, and private donors. These partners provide food, toiletries, household products, financial donations, and volunteers to equip and operate a handicapped accessible storefront on the grounds of St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Maumee.
