## Mission

The role of Usher has had a long history in the Catholic Church. Referred to as porters in the Third Century, Ushers used to guard the church doors against disruptive intruders. Today, Ushers serve the opposite function by welcoming parishioners and visitors to Mass. You are a minister of hospitality, and part of your ministry is to make people feel welcome. You will greet people as they come into the church and offer assistance as needed. You will minister in conjunction with the greeters who will be present at all outside doors. Your job as an Usher is to greet them a second time when they get into the Church or Family Center and to help them find a seat.
