The food truck will be with us on July 25-26 for the St. Anne's Day Celebrations.

**Kyle was nice enough to donate pulled pork sandwiches for the St. Anne's Day Festivities on July 25-26** (he suggested \$8 for a pulled pork sandwich, pickle spear and chips). 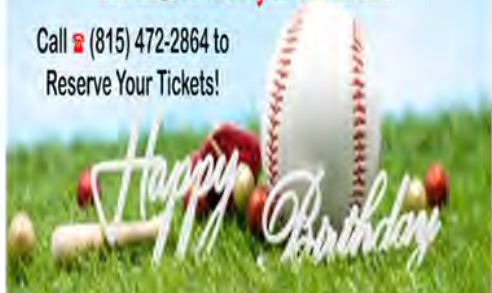

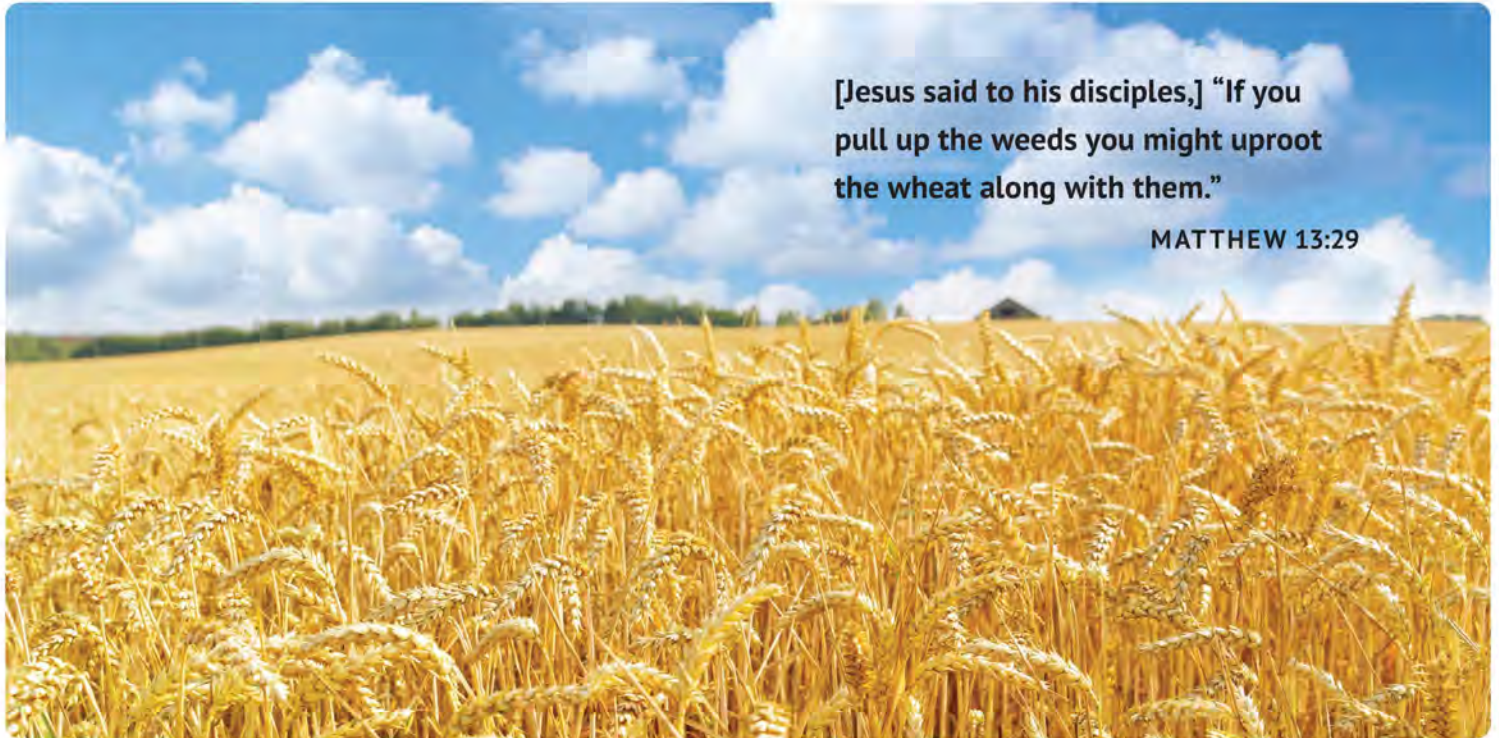

MATTHEW 13:29

## Weeds in Wheat

Jesus loved parables. “He spoke to them only in parables, to fulfill what had been said through the prophet: ‘I will open my mouth in parables, I will announce what has lain hidden from the foundation [of the world]’” (Matthew 13:34–35).

Indeed, parables spring from creation itself. Wheat and weeds grow, a natural process, just waiting for Jesus to read the kingdom of heaven hidden within. Jesus doesn’t force an interpretation on these elements; he, more than anyone, follows his own advice: “Whoever has ears ought to hear” (Matthew 13:43).

Matthew is the only gospel writer who records this parable. Maybe he liked it because it’s his own story. Among the beautiful wheat of the chosen people, he was an ugly weed, a tax collector for the Roman Empire. Once Jesus plucked him from obscurity to follow him, Matthew might have thought, *Why didn’t God just strike me dead for all the poison I spread among my own brethren?*

Now, in the parable, the weeds never become wheat, and they indeed meet a terrible fate, but the point is to let the wheat and weeds grow together, lest we uproot the wheat when we pull up the weeds. Oftentimes, it’s difficult to tell the difference. Those who are “wheat” should not find excuses to separate from those judged to be “weeds.” The risk is too great for the damage we may do. Let God do the separating in God’s own time. ●

***Are you tempted to give up on someone? Or yourself?***

# Dear Padre,

*My former boyfriend died recently. He was very abusive and caused me a lot of pain. Should I pray for him even if I believe that no amount of prayer could help him?*

Yes, you should pray for him and, despite your lingering hurt from the relationship, resist the urge to make a judgment about him. This decision is not only a healthy spiritual choice, but it will also help you heal the wounds that you still carry. Praying for him does not mean that you are denying any of the hurt that he inflicted on you but rather that you are capable of maturity and choices that were seemingly beyond his ability. Praying for him really says more about you than it says about him. It is also an act of grace-inspired honesty and faithfulness. It is a statement that you believe wholeheartedly in the merciful and forgiving God who is capable of healing the deepest hurts and is even capable of helping his faithful people ultimately forgive those who have inflicted harm upon them. ●

# St. Anne Church to Celebrate the Saint's Feast Day on July 26 with Masses, a Novena and Processions

All seemed hopeless for Joachim and Anne, a rich and pious childless couple, in regards for their wish to have a child. They both prayed, despite the fact that Anne was elderly. They knew that nothing was impossible for God.

Their prayers were answered when an angel appeared to Anne, saying she would give birth to a child who would be a blessing to the world. Anne named the child Miriam, which means Mary. (Yes, *that* Mary, the one who answered "yes" to God.)

"Without the efforts of Joachim and Anne, we don't get Mary, and without the Blessed Mother, we don't get the Savior of the world," said Father Peter Jankowski, the administrator at St. Anne Church in St. Anne, IL, and St. Patrick's in Momenca.

His church honors St. Anne on her feast day every year, on July 26, with Masses and a procession. In years past, thousands would travel to the church, which contains a national shrine to St. Anne and also possesses a first-class relic (defined as part of a saint's body) of St. Anne. The faithful venerate the relic as part of the feast-day festivities.

The church is also known as the site of several miraculous cures, Father Jankowski said. He cited a book called *Following Father Chiniquy: Immigration, Religious Schism, and Social Change in Nineteenth-Century Illinois*, written by Caroline Brettell, which chronicles St. Anne Church's early history.

The book also includes the miraculous healing of a 22-year-old named Matilda Cunnea, who traveled from Calumet City to the church in 1904 to venerate the relic. Cunnea's legs had been paralyzed for two years. But, after assisting in the daily prayers at the beginning of the novena to St. Anne, two days before the feast day, she told a nun that she thought she had been cured.

She asked the nun for help to get up out of her wheelchair. She then rose and began to walk. Cunnea's wheelchair is kept in a side chapel at St. Anne Church as a reminder of that miracle.

Food Trucks will be available for lunch and children's activities will begin at 11:00 a.m. We also thank Bethlehem Gifts from visiting us with their olivewood gifts for purchase. St. Anne's will provide the annual purchase of votive lamps, St. Anne Water and Oil as well as other devotional gifts for sale. St. Anne's is located on 230 N. 6th Ave. in St. Anne, IL. Beyond attendance at Mass, it's also important for the Catholic faithful to acknowledge and participate in processions and veneration of relics, Father Jankowski said. He eloquently talked about this during a homily earlier this year:

*"For those of us invested in the faith," he said, "we must keep embracing the signs, the symbols, the rituals, the traditions, the stories of the saints and of these holy people who have gone before us to remind ourselves of why we are here. The problem is, as always, that we forget; we get caught up with the way of the secular and the way of the negative sometimes instead of the way of the faith and that which is positive and holy in life. Through the life of faith and the example of those saints who have gone before us, we are able to encounter the presence of the divine within them and us, the path that directs us to heaven."*

# 18-19 Julio 2026: XVI Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

## TRADICIONES DE NUESTRA FE

Bartolomé de las Casas, el gran defensor de los indígenas, nació en Sevilla, España en 1474 y falleció en Madrid en el año 1566. Su larga vida fue dedicada a la presencia española en América.

Bartolomé llegó a la Nueva España para encargarse de una Encomienda. Después fue ordenado sacerdote y recibió a cargo una encomienda de mineros amerindios. Poco a poco su corazón cristiano le abrió los ojos a las injusticias españolas en América.

Por eso se hizo fraile dominico e hizo varios viajes a España en defensa de los derechos humanos de los amerindios ante los reyes de España, los cuales le dieron tierras en Venezuela y Chiapas para poner en práctica su teoría humanista acerca de los indígenas.

Hasta el fin de su vida este fraile y teólogo dominico luchó por los derechos de los nativos americanos, buscando convencer a los reyes españoles y a los Papas que la conquista no favorecía la evangelización de los pueblos. Gracias a sus esfuerzos se abolió la esclavitud indígena y se instituyó el diálogo, en lugar de la espada, como instrumento de conversión. - Fray Gilberto Cavazos Glz, OFM, Copyright © J S Paluch Co., Inc
