Rev. Achille Bergeron (d. 1921)

Father Bergeron, a Chicago priest, and once Pastor of Notre Dame Church there, is an important figure in our novena history. While the novena began in our parish in 1881, Father Bergeron led the first pilgrimage to our church on July 26, 1886. The pilgrims came by train. Word of the Shrine at St. Anne soon spread far beyond our parish boundaries. Father Bergeron led pilgrims here for many years thereafter. He is counted as a great benefactor of the Shrine.

FROM FR. PETE JANKOWSKI

For the 145th time, St. Anne's Church (the small city with the big heart, aka "Our little slice of heaven") welcomes pilgrims throughout the area in joining us for this yearly devotion that has offered spiritual and physical healings over the last century and a half. We are honored that Chicago priest **Fr. James Heyd**, Viatorian Priest **Rev. Jhobany Orduz, CSV** and Latin Mass priest **Rev. John Rickert, FSSP** will be celebrating Masses in English, Spanish and Latin respectively on this important day for us.

When Fr. Jim Heyd spoke to me about his French heritage and his yearly journey with the faithful Haitian community he serves in Chicago, I referenced him as the *New Achilles Bergeron* of the 21st Century. As a child living in Bourbonnais, Fr. Bergeron and his family used to make this yearly sojourn to St. Anne and he realized the importance of that relic and the power of healing contained within. As a result, Fr. Bergeron continued this custom with the faithful he served in the

Chicagoland area by taking them by train to St. Anne, IL each year to pray on this feast day.

As a result, many of the faithful from Fr. Bergeron's community received those physical and spiritual healings, including Matilda Cunea, whose who healed from her illness; wheelchair has adorned the back of our church ever since.

As time passes and stories are forgotten, I reminded Fr. Heyd that as Fr. Bergeron made a difference for the people he served in the early 20th Century, so Fr. Jim can do the same for those he serves today. Once we realize the sacred gift that is present in front of us, then we do not take it for granted and we return to venerate that relic so that God can work through the relic and allow that grace to pass through us.

Whatever you can do to help us with this Novena and Feast Day would be much appreciated. For a parish that averages \$1,300 a week in the collection, the cost of the Novena runs about \$10,000 a year. It would be best if we established a foundation so that this mission of grace may continue in the decades ahead. Anything that you can do to maintain what has been offered for almost one hundred fifty years may continue.



The Ways of Praying



Consider how there are five levels of communication, each level taking us deeper into a relationship and what it means to be human. *One*, the greetings we offer as we pass: Good morning! How's it going? *Two*, a sharing of activities: what we did, what someone said. *Three*, an expression of ideas, as in what we think about raising children or our political opinions or why we believe there may be conflicts in the world. *Four*, revealing our feelings both positive and negative: feelings of love or gratitude or contentment as well as of being hurt or rejected or disappointed. *Five*, a sense of intense closeness and *being with*, perhaps even without speaking or using any words. Each level, then, takes us deeper into a shared relationship.

Consider, then, how ever-deepening prayer may follow that same pattern. *One*, memorized or rote prayer. *Two*, telling God what is on our mind, even though it is a one-sided conversation. *Three*, commonly called “meditation” but, more simply, thinking about God and life and our faith response, as in the musing that may follow spiritual reading. *Four*, often referred to as “praying our feelings,” such as reflecting on our human emotions and what they might say about us, our faith, and how the journey of our faith life is unfolding. *Five*, a sense of simply *being with* God, even without words, and simply resting in that holy presence. Each level of prayer, then, leads us ever more into a shared relationship with our God. ●

Reflect

How do I pray? Should I ask for the grace to grow in my prayer life?



[Jesus said to his disciples,]
“And I tell you, ask and you
will receive; seek and you
will find; knock and the
door will be opened to you.”

LUKE 11:9

Dear Padre,

Who wrote the Lord's Prayer? I know the Lord's Prayer comes from Scripture, but who composed it as we say it today?

When the disciples asked the Lord to teach them to pray, he taught them the prayer we know as the Our Father. Two versions of that prayer appear in the Gospels of Matthew and Luke. The version used in the Church's liturgies is derived from Matthew 6:9–13. In fact, citing St. Thomas Aquinas' *Summa Theologiae*, the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* calls the Lord's Prayer the "most perfect of prayers" (2774), teaching us not only what things to pray for in our prayer but also in what order, or priority, we should desire them. It is at the heart of every individual and communal prayer.

We pray the Our Father, bearing in mind and heart the intimate relationship we have with our God as sons and daughters by adoption through our baptism. The specific wording of our prayers is a work in progress. What we think of as the final wording is that which the Church has approved and makes the most sense for prayer as a community. What is most important is that the substance of the prayer reflects the same matter the Lord used in the prayer. ●
