Dear Alumni, Momence Business Partners and Friends of St. Patrick's:

In an upcoming edition of Momence's local newspaper, **THE PROGRESS REPORTER**, Anita Allison will present a story about our Academy's Gymnasium and the role it plays in the city. As the largest venue in Momence (outside of the local schools), St. Patrick's Gym has opened its doors in supporting various projects on the city's behalf, from events associated with the August Gladiolus Festival to large funeral luncheons and religious events on behalf of the surrounding churches. We have come to realize that this building serves an important role in the city and that upgrades are needed so that we can continue providing necessary services that help out this community.

Towards this cause, we have addressed roof issues that eventually took its toll on the academy building, which had to be leveled some years ago, causing the parish to incur a \$300,000 debt. The debt is an issue for the parish; the upgrade of the gym is necessary for those who use the gym, something perhaps you might be able to help us address.

I have utilized the services of paver John Lucas and architect Richard Snyder to visit our facilities and provide us as estimate as to what kind of monies we would need to spend to upgrade the gym. Per their report, renovating a gym floor would run us about \$20,000... creating special needs bathrooms and a warming kitchen on each side of our gym stage would run us about \$150,000. To create a parking lot by the gym would run us another \$150,000. To pave the current parking lot behind our church (which would allow folks to walk to the gymnasium) would run about \$70,000.

Obviously these big ticket items cannot be addressed all at once. Thus, we are offering smaller opportunities for your consideration, which accompany this letter...

- Perhaps you might be able to support us through a \$100 SPONSORSHIP SIGN which will be adorned at ST. PATRICK'S FALL FESTIVAL ON OCTOBER 9, 2021 and ST. PATRICK'S GOLF OUTING ON JUNE 18, 2022 AT THE MINNIE MONESSE GOLF CLUB IN GRANT PARK. (You may also consider golfing at this event at \$100 a person (for groups of four), which includes golf, cart and dinner).
- You may wish to consider buying **\$20 DECEMBER DRAWING TICKETS** that will net our church a potential \$9,000 profit to help our parish. We can reach this goal by selling all 1000 tickets.
