1. If someone asked you what you believed as a Catholic, what do you think you would tell them?
2. Do you really listen to yourself and understand what you are saying weekly at Mass when you recite the Creed that starts off with, "**I believe...**"?
3. When you recite, "I believe in one God..." what is your perception of God? Do you think it's an informed perception? If so, how do you think it's an informed perception??
4. How does Jesus / the bible talking about God influence your perception about who God is?
5. How do you think we should respond to the revelation of who God is? Do we (you) do a good job of that?
6. If we have faith, does that mean that we may not struggle sometimes or have obstacles to fully understanding God and revelation?
7. If through revelation we learn who God is, and because of that we receive the gift of faith, do you think that means we don't have to nourish it and ensure it continues to grow? Or do you think faith itself seek understanding?
8. How do you think we can continue to nourish our faith? How do you think we should exercise our faith in the daily activities of our life?
9. Is that always easy to do? Do people recognize you as a person of faith? As a Catholic? How do you struggle daily to live a life of faith.
