Nov 16, 2025 – Saints- Their Example of the Christian Life

1. Think about what your Confirmation Saint is known for and/or why you're choosing to take their name. Provide examples of how you can you reflect their "charism" in your own life; remember, a charism refers to ways in which the Holy Spirit "distributes special graces among the faithful of every rank" for the building up of the Church (CCC 951).

Then, provide examples of how you can put your own spin on this charism and become the saint you've been created to be.

- For example, maybe you're taking the name "Sebastian" because you're an athlete, but you've also been blessed with the gift of leadership; how can you combine these gifts so that you can grow in holiness by being a team player?
2. Who passed on the Catholic faith to you and who continues to inspire you to live it? These might not be the same person! How did these people enrich your faith by sharing it with you? How can you enrich the faith of someone else by sharing it with them? (CCC 949)
 3. What are some examples of how you can be a saint in your daily routine so that "the least of our acts done in charity redounds to the profit of all" (CCC 953)? Think of how Carlo brought Tupperware full of food to the homeless or shared the faith with his friends while they were playing video games.
 4. As we know, when the saints enter into Heaven, they are "put in charge of many things," often resulting in them becoming the patron saint of those particular things. (CCC 2683). What do you think you might be the patron saint of someday?
