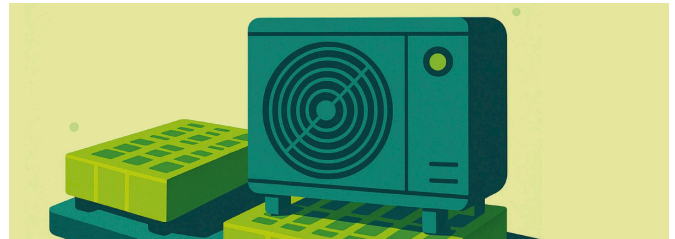
VASO Battery Energy Storage System Unit

Battery energy storage is now recognised as a cornerstone of the UK's net zero transition – essential for capturing surplus renewable power, stabilising the grid and enabling clean energy to be delivered reliably and affordably.

VASO was delighted to design, deliver and install a bespoke BESS unit for a client in December 2025. The VASO BESS unit is a custom-engineered solution featuring integrated thermal management, swift deployment capabilities, and a structural design with a reduced carbon footprint compared to conventional containerised systems.

This project demonstrates how the innovative VASO BESS solution can unlock more renewable generation opportunities.

VASO Heat Pump Base Panel

This month, we highlight our collaboration with the [Centre for Net Zero High Density Buildings](#) to advance the [VASO Heat Pump Base Panel](#) – an engineered, non concrete alternative designed to support faster, higher quality heat pump installations.

With UK targets of 600,000 installations per year by 2028, the product aligns directly with the Heat Pump Ready Programme's focus on deployment efficiency and installation quality.
