Electrical Safety Presentations



July 30-31, 2025

Energy in Today's Classroom, presented by Central Electric Power Cooperative in Jefferson City, provides a unique hands-on experience for Missouri's middle school and high school teachers. The two-day workshop is designed to fully support Missouri's statewide education standards and provides teachers with a background in energy and energy production. Teachers attending the course receive 15 hours of classroom training. Upon successful completion, those hours can be converted into 15 Professional Development hours.
