

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY OF NEMAHA, KANSAS TO LEVY A PROPERTY TAX RATE EXCEEDING THE REVENUE NEUTRAL RATE;

WHEREAS, the Revenue Neutral Rate for the County of Nemaha was calculated as 35.379 mills by the Nemaha County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the budget proposed by the Governing Body of the County of Nemaha will require the levy of a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body held a hearing on August 25, 2025 allowing all interested taxpayers desiring to be heard an opportunity to give oral testimony; and


WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the County of Nemaha, having heard testimony, still finds it necessary to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE COUNTY OF NEMAHA:




The County of Nemaha shall levy a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate of 35.379 mills.

This resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and shall remain in effect until future action is taken by the Governing Body.


