RESOLUTION NO. 2026-3

A RESOLUTION TERMINATING THE COUNTY'S  
PARTICIPATION IN KWORCC EFFECTIVE AT THE END OF  
THE DAY ON DECEMBER 31, 2026 AND REPEALING ALL  
CONFLICTING RESOLUTIONS OR PORTIONS THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nemaha County, Kansas adopted Resolution Number 2023-5 electing to participate in the county self-insurance pool for workers compensation coverage managed by the Kansas Workers Risk Cooperative for Counties (KWORCC); and

WHEREAS, Section 12.1 of the Bylaws and Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for KWORCC provides as follows:

Any member may withdraw from the Cooperative, effective on the anniversary date subsequent to written notice of withdrawal provided to the Board, by resolution of the Member's governing body. The written notice of such withdrawal must be provided to the Board no later than sixty (60) days prior to the anniversary date of the Cooperative.; and

WHEREAS, KWORCC has identified on its website that KWORCC was established to commence service to its members on January 1, 1992. See <https://www.kworcc.com/> ; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of County Commissioners of Nemaha County, Kansas to terminate Nemaha County's participation in the county self-insurance pool for workers compensation coverage managed by the Kansas Workers Risk Cooperative for Counties (KWORCC) and to terminate and withdraw from Nemaha County's membership in KWORCC with an effective date of the end of the day on December 31, 2026.

NOW WHEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NEMAHA COUNTY, KANSAS:

Section 1. Termination of Participation in Self-Insurance Pool and Withdrawal from Membership in KWORCC

The Board of County Commissioners of Nemaha County, Kansas hereby formally resolves that it is terminating Nemaha County's participation in the county self-insurance pool for workers compensation coverage managed by the Kansas Workers Risk Cooperative for Counties (KWORCC) effective as of the end of the day on December 31, 2026. Furthermore, said Board of County Commissioners hereby formally resolves to terminate and withdraw from Nemaha County's membership in KWORCC with an effective date as of the end of the day on December 31, 2026.

Section 2. Acknowledgement of Compliance with K.S.A. 12-2626(c)

The Board of County Commissioners of Nemaha County, Kansas understands that KWORCC will notify the division of workers' compensation for the State of Kansas within ten (10) days of the date of this letter. Additionally, said Board of County Commissioners further understands that KWORCC shall maintain coverage for Nemaha County, Kansas until the earlier of (a) thirty (30) days after the effective date (the end of the day on December 31, 2026) of the County's termination notice resolution enclosed herein or (b) the first date after the effective date (December 31, 2026) of the County's termination notice resolution enclosed on which said division of workers' compensation for the State of Kansas gives notice to KWORCC that Nemaha County, Kansas has procured replacement workers' compensation insurance from an alternative vendor with an effective date commencing on or before January 1, 2027.

Section 3. Repeal

All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are repealed. However, any section of an existing resolution not in conflict herewith is not repealed and remains in full force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date

This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after publication in the official county newspaper.
